



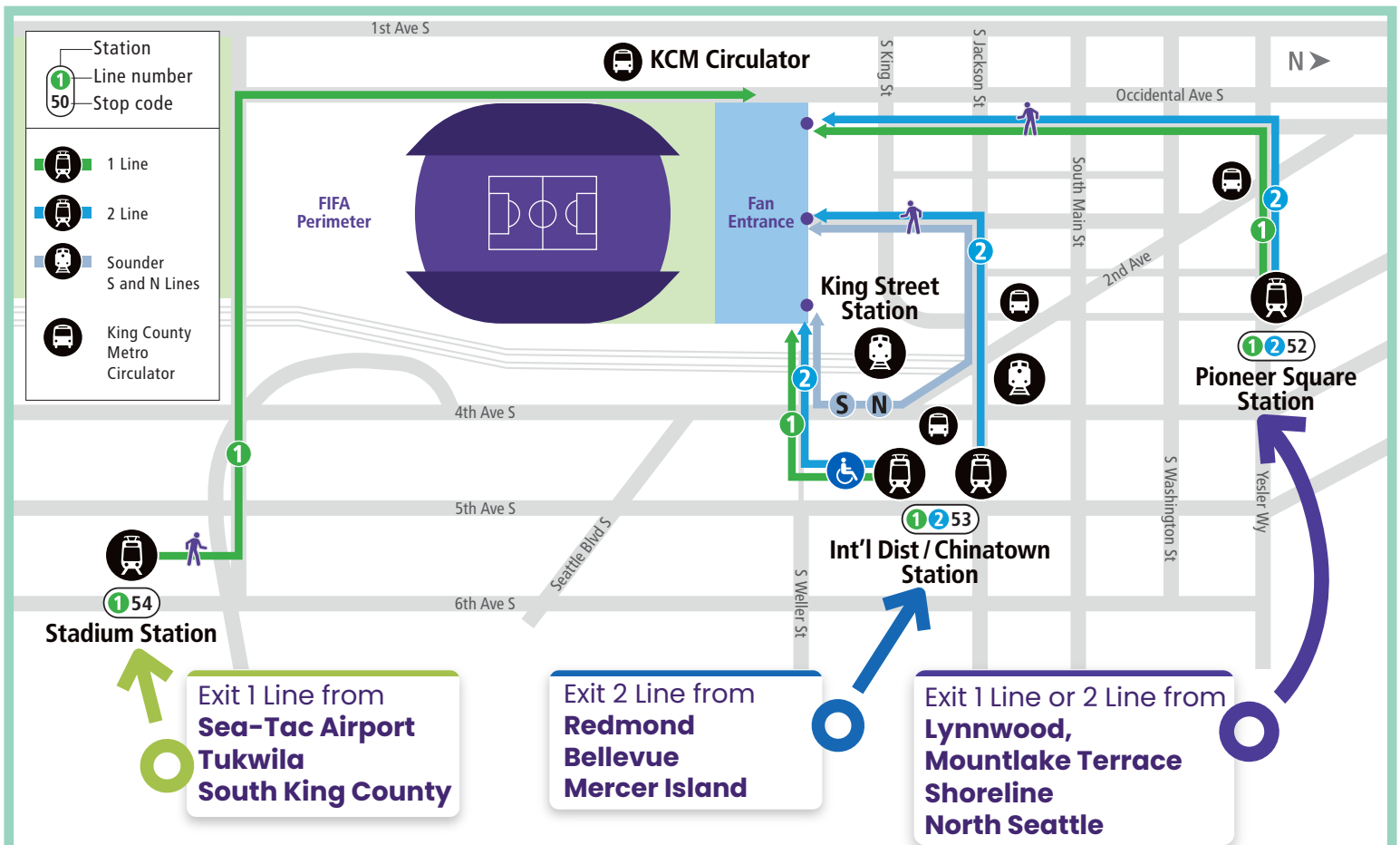
Sound Transit is committed to providing a safe, clean, and reliable transit service to help you travel the region during the tournament.



From June 15 to July 6, Seattle Stadium will host six matches.

Match Day: Which Station Should I Use?

To keep crowds moving safely, use the following stations to Seattle Stadium.



For people with reduced mobility, we will offer **priority boarding** on trains, with decals indicating where to board at specific stations.

Please use **International District/Chinatown Station** for the most direct, accessible path from Link to Seattle Stadium via the Weller Street Bridge.

Sound Transit staff will be at key stations to help passengers find their destinations and pay for transit.

Taking Light Rail



On match day, expect trains **every eight minutes** on the 1 Line and 2 Line. For the first time, passengers can take the light rail from Redmond and Bellevue across Lake Washington directly to International District/Chinatown Station and downtown Seattle.



Tap-to-Pay

You can use a major credit or debit card—or a phone's digital wallet—on yellow readers to ride transit. One tap equals one person.

\$18 Three-Day Regional Pass

Grab a 3-day regional pass for \$18 (+\$3 card fee) to enjoy **unlimited rides** on Sound Transit and most partner networks across the area. **Purchase your pass from ticket vending machines at Sound Transit stations.**



Station Parking

Parking will be limited during the tournament—skip the car and travel by bus, foot, bike, scooter, taxi, or rideshare to your station.
